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3. Effective April 1, 2019, the Company adopted Ind AS 116 "Leases", applied to all lease contracts existing ou April 1, 2019 using the modified retrospective method. Accordingly, comparatives for the year ended March 31, 2019 have not been retrospectively adjusted. On transition, the adoption of the new standard resulted in recognition of Right-of-Use asset (ROU) of Rs. 85, 26 lakhs and a lease hability of Rs. 85, 26 lakhs. The effect of this adoption is insignificant on the profit for the period and earnings per share.

4. The aforesaid financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" (Ind AS 34) prescribed ander Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereander and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
